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1. Introduction

WORKS TECH CAPITAL INTERNATIONAL L.L.C. (“WORKS”, “we”, “us”, or “our”) respects the privacy of individuals who visit our website, contact us, enquire about our services, engage with us in a business or professional capacity, or otherwise interact with the Company.

This Privacy Policy explains how WORKS may collect, use, store, share, and protect personal information in connection with its website, digital channels, communications, services, projects, business relationships, and other authorized activities.

WORKS is a Wyoming limited liability company organized under the laws of the State of Wyoming, United States of America.

This Policy is intended to apply subject to the privacy and data protection requirements that may be applicable to the relevant individual, activity, service, or jurisdiction.

2. Scope of this Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy applies to personal information collected by **WORKS TECH CAPITAL INTERNATIONAL L.L.C.** in connection with:

- visits to and use of our website and digital channels;
- enquiries, forms, emails, telephone calls, WhatsApp, and other authorized communications;
- prospective and existing client relationships;
- suppliers, contractors, consultants, service providers, and business partners;
- proposals, projects, contracts, and professional engagements;
- marketing, business development, meetings, and professional interactions;
- recruitment-related communications, where applicable; and
- other legitimate business interactions with WORKS.

Where WORKS processes personal information on behalf of a client or another organization as part of a specific service or project, additional privacy and data protection terms may apply under the relevant contractual arrangements.



3. Personal Information We May Collect

Depending on how you interact with **WORKS TECH CAPITAL INTERNATIONAL L.L.C.**, we may collect and process the following categories of personal information:

Identity & Contact Information

This may include your name, job title, organization, business address, email address, telephone or mobile number, and other contact information you choose to provide.

Business & Professional Information

This may include your role, business requirements, project or service information, proposal or contract details, professional correspondence, and other information relevant to a business relationship or engagement.

Website & Technical Information

Where applicable, we may collect technical and usage information such as IP address, browser type, device type, operating system, access times, pages viewed, referring source, and similar information generated through use of our website or digital services.

Communications

We may retain records of enquiries, emails, messages, meetings, and other communications relevant to our interactions with you.

Transaction & Payment Information

Where applicable, we may process information necessary to administer quotations, invoices, payments, and related business records. Payment card or banking information may be processed directly by authorized financial institutions or payment service providers rather than stored by WORKS.



4. How We Collect Personal Information

We may collect personal information:

- directly from you when you contact us, submit an enquiry, complete a form, or communicate with us through an authorized channel;
- when you enter into discussions, proposals, contracts, projects, or other business arrangements with us;
- through your use of our website, digital channels, and related technologies;
- through professional, business, or project-related correspondence;
- from the organization you represent, work for, or are otherwise associated with;
- from publicly available professional, corporate, or business sources;
- from business partners, suppliers, service providers, advisers, or other relevant third parties where appropriate; and
- through third-party platforms or services when you choose to interact with WORKS through those channels.

Where personal information is obtained from a source other than the individual concerned, WORKS will handle that information in accordance with the privacy and data protection requirements applicable to the

5. How We Use Personal Information

We may use personal information for purposes including:

- responding to enquiries, requests, and communications;
- understanding business, project, service, and professional requirements;
- preparing proposals, quotations, contracts, and related documentation;
- providing, managing, supporting, and improving our services, projects, and digital activities;
- managing relationships with clients, suppliers, contractors, advisers, service providers, and business partners;
- administering invoices, payments, financial records, and related business documentation;
- operating, maintaining, securing, and improving our website, systems, communications, and digital channels;
- conducting appropriate marketing, business development, and professional communications;
- managing internal administration, governance, records, and operational processes;
- complying with applicable legal, regulatory, tax, accounting, contractual, and corporate requirements;
- protecting our rights, systems, business interests, and the security of our operations; and
- preventing misuse, fraud, unlawful activity, or other risks.

We will not use personal information for purposes that are incompatible with the purpose for which it was collected unless such use is permitted or required by applicable law.



6. Legal Bases & Business Purposes for Processing

Depending on the circumstances and the applicable law, **WORKS TECH CAPITAL INTERNATIONAL L.L.C.** may process personal information on one or more of the following bases or for the following legitimate business purposes:

- **Consent** — where you have provided consent for a specific purpose and such consent is required or appropriate.
- **Contractual Necessity** — where processing is necessary to take steps at your request before entering into a contract, or to perform or administer a contractual relationship.
- **Legitimate Business Purposes** — where processing is reasonably necessary to manage business relationships, respond to enquiries, operate and improve our services, maintain effective administration, protect our systems and business interests, or support appropriate business development.
- **Legal or Regulatory Obligations** — where processing is necessary to comply with applicable legal, regulatory, tax, accounting, corporate, or other mandatory requirements.
- **Protection of Rights, Security & Business Interests** — where processing is reasonably necessary to protect legal rights, prevent misuse or fraud, maintain security, manage risk, or establish, exercise, or defend legal claims.
- **Other Permitted Grounds** — where processing is otherwise permitted or required under applicable privacy or data protection law.

Where processing is based on consent, you may withdraw that consent at any time, subject to applicable law and without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out before withdrawal.

7. Business & Professional Contacts

In the course of its business activities, **WORKS TECH CAPITAL INTERNATIONAL L.L.C.** may collect and use professional contact information relating to individuals who represent, work for, advise, supply, partner with, or otherwise interact with companies, institutions, service providers, contractors, clients, prospective clients, and other business organizations.

This information may include a person's name, job title, organization, business contact details, professional role, correspondence, and other information reasonably relevant to the business relationship.

9. Cookies & Similar Technologies

Our website may use cookies and similar technologies to support its operation, security, functionality, performance, and, where enabled, analytics or other optional features.

Cookies may help us remember preferences, understand how the website is used, improve user experience, maintain security, and support certain website functions.

Where required by applicable law, non-essential cookies or similar technologies will not be used without the appropriate consent.

Further information about the types of cookies we use, their purposes, retention periods, and available choices is provided in our **Cookie Policy**.

10. Sharing Personal Information

WORKS TECH CAPITAL INTERNATIONAL L.L.C. does not sell personal information.

We may share personal information where reasonably necessary with:

- employees, officers, or authorized representatives of WORKS;
- professional advisers, including legal, tax, accounting, regulatory, and other consultants;
- technology, hosting, cloud, software, communications, and IT service providers;
- payment, banking, or financial service providers, where applicable;
- suppliers, contractors, subcontractors, specialists, or other service providers involved in delivering an agreed service or project;



- business partners where necessary for an authorized engagement or business activity;
- governmental, regulatory, law-enforcement, judicial, or other competent authorities where required or permitted by law; and
- other parties where disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect legal rights, manage risk, prevent misuse or fraud, or establish, exercise, or defend legal claims.

Where third parties process personal information on behalf of WORKS, we seek to use appropriate contractual, organizational, and technical arrangements according to the nature of the processing and applicable requirements.

11. Third-Party Service Providers

WORKS TECH CAPITAL INTERNATIONAL L.L.C. may use third-party service providers to support the operation and delivery of its website, digital services, communications, business processes, projects, and professional activities.

15. Your Privacy Rights

16. Automated Decision-Making
